Velcro fastenings on shoes are much easier for the younger children to manage.

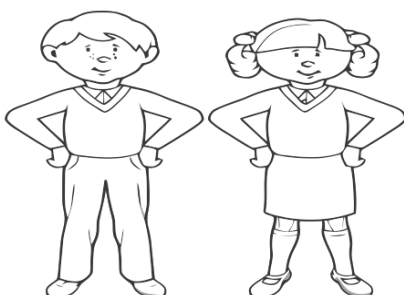
Shoulder length hair must be tied back.

Sandals must have fully covered toes to prevent accidents and injury.

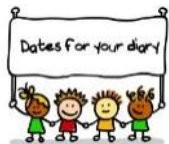
