Week beginning – Monday 12th June

This week we are learning about...

	<p>Topic</p> <p>We are going to be learning in greater depth about famous shipwrecks, from around the world and also beginning to look at some of the notorious pirates, who sailed the seas. The children will have an opportunity to learn about ones which interest them. They will need to look at where in the world they were, the background stories and famous events.</p>
	<p>English / Literacy</p> <p>We will be continuing to explore comprehension skills; this week focussing upon synonyms and antonyms and their usage in texts. The children will be building on their work creating images in the reader's mind from last week and using this when exploring the book 'Flotsam' by David Weisner and using images as stimulus for our own writing.</p>
	<p>Phonics and Spellings</p> <p>There are new spelling list coming home this week. These are also on our website.</p>
	<p>Numeracy and Maths</p> <p>We will be working upon our skills and strategies required when using decimals in addition, subtraction and ordering. We shall be looking for clues from decimals and looking for ways to work with repeated multiples of decimals in addition and subtraction. Finally we will be using decimals in measuring problems.</p>
