This week we are learning about...

	<p>Topic</p> <p>We are going to be learning in greater depth about famous shipwrecks, from around the world and also beginning to look at some of the notorious pirates, who sailed the seas. The children will have an opportunity to learn about ones which interest them. They will need to look at where in the world they were, the background stories and famous events.</p>
	<p>English / Literacy</p> <p>We will be continuing to explore comprehension skills; this week focussing upon synonyms and antonyms and their usage in texts. The children will be writing their own shipwrecked poetry, which will also become part of their homework. We will also begin to explore how Flotsam can be used for creative writing.</p>
	<p>Phonics and Spellings</p> <p>There are new spelling list coming home this week. These are also on our website.</p>
	<p>Numeracy and Maths</p> <p>We will be working upon our skills and strategies required when looking for fractions of numbers and relating these fractions to decimals.</p>
